- 40 **PIGALLE BRUT** £16.00  
France NV  
A soft fruity style with a touch of crisp apple and nectarine flavours.
- 41 **ASTI SPUMANTE, SANT' ORSOLA** £19.90  
Italy NV £4.10  
Elegant, yet richly fruity bouquet matched by a deliciously concentrated flavour on the palate and a stylish grapey acidity on the finish.
- 42 **CODORNÍU PINOT NOIR BRUT ROSÉ, CAVA** £21.90  
Spain NV £4.60  
A delicious style of ripe summer fruit aromas so typical of well made Pinot Noir.

- 43 **BOUCHÉ PÈRE ET FILS CUVÉE RÉSERVÉE BRUT NV** £32.50

Family passion takes all three grapes from south of Epernay and results in bubbles of baked apple deliciousness.
- 44 **BOUCHÉ PÈRE ET FILS BRUT ROSÉ NV** £38.50  
A predominance of Pinot Noir gives a rich summer strawberry fruit flavour.
- 45 **PIPER-HEIDSIECK BRUT NV** 75ml Bottle £39.00  
1.5cl Bottle (Magnum) £79.00  
3cl Bottle (Jeroboam) £159.00  
Young, lively fruit flavours, a fresh, vivid aroma and assertive crispness characterise this vivacious Champagne.
- 46 **TAITTINGER BRUT RÉSERVE NV** £44.50  
Perhaps the lightest and most elegant of the Grand Marque Champagnes, an intensely fragrant character, subtle biscuity complexity and superb elegance from a predominance of Chardonnay.
- 47 **TAITTINGER PRESTIGE BRUT ROSÉ NV** £49.50  
Stylish and dry with delicious summer fruit aromas and a long, full-bodied flavour typical of Pinot Noir based Champagnes.
- 48 **VEUVE CLICQUOT YELLOW LABEL BRUT NV** £47.50  
Reflecting the traditions of the past, this is full, yet dry and has a rich, creamy style with biscuity flavours.
- 49 **PERRIER-JOUËT BELLE EPOQUE BRUT 2002** £129.00  
A prestige cuvée renowned for great length and elegance, these bubbles are also bursting with seductive, ripe berry richness.
- 50 **LOUIS ROEDERER CRISTAL BRUT 2004** £195.00  
Aromas of green apple, caramel and lemon zest; with concentrated, minerally flavours that announce apples served with cream.
- 51 **DOM PÉRIGNON BRUT 2002** £139.00  
Long and satisfying on the palate with layers of yeasty, nutty flavours, superbly fat and ripe. Complex, luxury Grand Cru Champagne made only in the best years.

France 2009/10  
Full-flavoured freshness heaped with apple ripeness giving way to a softer style, distinctive of its southern provenance.

A good example from this most popular of the Beaujolais Cru. The name Fleurie aptly describes the fresh, floral style of the wine.

Chile 2010/1 £5.80

Fragrant aromas of lemon and gooseberries with a zesty finish.
- 2 **PINOT GRIGIO DI PAVIA, COLLEZIONE MARCHESINI** £16.00  
Italy 2009/10 £5.80  
£4.50  
Lovely buttery, crisp and dry style with typical pear fruit from this area of central northern Italy in the southern section of Lombardy.
- 3 **BERRI ESTATES UNOAKED CHARDONNAY, SE AUSTRALIA** £16.00  
Australia 2007/8 £5.80  
£4.50  
A crisp style with a fresh, yet ripe lemon character with no oak ageing.

- 20 **VENDANGE WHITE ZINFANDEL, CALIFORNIA** £16.00

A brief time with juice and skin together gives this delicate colour, delicious strawberry aroma and zingy freshness.

France 2009/10  
Deliciously dry and fruity, gamay grapes from the Côte Mâconnais brim with red berry flavours and a crisp freshness.

Soft, warm and smooth red with lots of blackcurrant and plum fruits and a dash of spice.

- 23 **BERRI ESTATES SHIRAZ, SE AUSTRALIA** £16.00  
Australia 2008/9 £5.80  
£4.50  
Medium-bodied and fruity with raspberry, cherry and plum, complemented by vanilla spices.

**WHITE**

- 4 **FIANO SICILIA, SANT' ORSOLA** **£19.00**  
Italy 2009/10  
Honeyed palate with flavours of white peach, pear, lemon and hints of hazelnut, so typical of the Fiano variety.
- 5 **VERAMONTE SAUVIGNON BLANC RESERVA, CASABLANCA VALLEY** **£17.50**  
Chile 2010/1  
Fine example of cool-climate Chilean Sauvignon with fresh-cut grass and gooseberries and a hint of green pepper.
- 6 **SANCERRE, LES COLLINETTES, JOSEPH MELLOTT** **£25.50**  
France 2009/10  
Stylish and crisp aromas of gooseberries and powerful fruit flavours, linked with a clean finish, from one of the finest and most dynamic producers.
- 7 **GEWÜRZTRAMINER ALSACE, F.E. TRIMBACH** **£30.00**  
France 2007/8  
This distinctive grape coupled with this great producer ensures all the spicy ripeness and peach character one expects and always enjoys.
- 8 **SOAVE TUSAIE, BOLLA** **£23.50**  
Italy 2008/9  
Shows a minerality rare in Soaves, green apple and floral notes appear on the bright, fresh finish.
- 9 **LEASINGHAM MAGNUS RIESLING, CLARE VALLEY** **£19.00**  
Australia 2009/10  
Cool-climate, refreshing Riesling packed full of citrus aromas and flavour with excellent balance of acidity and fruit.
- 10 **PINOT GRIGIO COLLIO SANT' HELENA, FANTINEL** **£23.00**  
Italy 2009/10  
Wonderful aromas of freshly dried hay, pear and honeyed pineapple enveloped in creamy almond.
- 11 **MÂCON-VILLAGES DOMAINE DE LA GRANGE MAGNIEN, LOUIS JADOT** **£23.00**  
France 2009/10  
Excellent softer style of Burgundy. Fresh, full flavoured with pleasant citrus and buttery undertones.
- 12 **CHABLIS, DOMAINE GILBERT PICQ ET FILS** **£26.00**  
France 2008/9  
This is a dry, ripe Chardonnay of great style, with the gunflint characteristic for which the region is famous.
- 13 **NOBILO ICON SAUVIGNON BLANC, MARLBOROUGH** **£28.00**  
New Zealand 2010/1  
A complex, powerful wine displaying the traditional Marlborough Sauvignon Blanc characters of gooseberry and nettles combined with rich herbal and tropical characters. Crisp, balanced finish.
- 14 **BOURGOGNE CHARDONNAY COUVENT DES JACOBINS, LOUIS JADOT** **£24.00**  
France 2009/10  
Generous richness laden with butter coated peaches, mature barrique character exudes a mouth-filling roundness.
- 15 **CULLINAN VIEW CHENIN BLANC, ROBERTSON** **£17.50**  
South Africa 2010/1  
Deliciously fresh and creamy with peachy fruit character. A classic South African style.
- 16 **HOUGHTON THE BANDIT SAUVIGNON-PINOT GRIS, WESTERN AUSTRALIA** **£21.50**  
Australia 2010/1  
Warm, soft pineapple and passion fruit aromas followed by rounded lemon and pears with a soft gentle finish..
- 17 **VIDAL SAUVIGNON BLANC, MARLBOROUGH** **£22.50**  
New Zealand 2009/10  
Classically crisp and herbaceously intense with great complexity, a mingling of passion-fruit and melon flavours
- 18 **PIESPORTER MICHELBERG, J BRADER** **£17.50**  
Germany 2010/1  
This tiny village and dramatic steep vineyards give a distinctive mineral character, fresh and lively.

**RED**

- 24 **CHÂTEAU LAMOTHE-CISSAC, CRU BOURGEOIS HAUT-MÉDOC** **£24.50**  
France 2004  
Deep garnet wine with a blackcurrant and cedar nose, it tastes round and ripe with a good, firm finish. An excellent Haut-Médoc Château.
- 25 **NOBILO ICON PINOT NOIR, MARLBOROUGH** **£29.50**  
New Zealand 2009/10  
Rich, concentrated with some new oak flavours backing up vibrant cherry and smooth plum fruit.
- 26 **CHÂTEAU LA TOUR DE BESSAN, CRU BOURGEOIS MARGAUX** **£39.50**  
France 2007  
An harmonious marriage of the three traditional Bordeaux grapes. A round, supple style with a soft blackcurrant richness.
- 27 **HOUGHTON THE BANDIT SHIRAZ-TEMPRANILLO, WESTERN AUSTRALIA** **£21.50**  
Australia 2008/9  
Innovative blend with vibrant primary sweet-berry fruit coupled with savoury spice and gentle oak.
- 28 **MÂCON ROUGE, LOUIS JADOT** **£23.00**  
France 2009/10  
The vibrant Gamay grape exudes sumptuous strawberry freshness and a delightful summer day wistfulness.
- 29 **FETZER ZINFANDEL, CALIFORNIA** **£23.50**  
USA 2008/9  
The warm Sierra foothills ensure vibrant redcurrant succulence with generous roasted black pepper.
- 30 **VERAMONTE MERLOT RESERVA, CASABLANCA VALLEY** **£19.00**  
Chile 2006/7  
Richly full of black berry and cherry aromas with hints of mint and a creamy velvet texture.
- 31 **DON JACOBO RIOJA CRIANZA TINTO, BODEGAS CORRAL** **£21.00**  
Spain 2006/7  
Abundant bright raspberry aromas mingle with sumptuous cherries and layered with a creamy barrique character.
- 32 **RISERVA DUCALE CHIANTI CLASSICO RISERVA, RUFFINO** **£31.00**  
Italy 2006/7  
Rich and concentrated, a dark, minerally palate and roasted red fruit and herb character.
- 33 **CULLINAN VIEW PINOTAGE, ROBERTSON** **£18.50**  
South Africa 2010/1  
Rich, full and spicy with good levels of fruit aromas and flavour, made with South Africa's own grape variety.
- 34 **BAROLO LO ZOCCOLAIO, DOMINI VILLA LANATA** **£41.00**  
Italy 2006  
Specially selected Nebbiolo grapes give heady aromas of violets and bramble berry characters enveloped in large oak barrique complexity, a classic from a top producer.
- 35 **FLEURIE LES MURIENNES, THORIN** **£21.50**  
France 2009/10  
The name Fleurie aptly describes the fresh, floral style of the wine.
- 36 **CHÂTEAUNEUF-DU-PAPE, RESERVE DE L'ARNESQUE** **£32.90**  
France 2008/9  
Uncover the secret of Galets and how they help to exude such heady spiced berry abundance laden with generous creamy oak.
- 37 **LEASINGHAM BIN 61 SHIRAZ, CLARE VALLEY** **£22.90**  
Australia 2006/7  
Lots of sweet, plum fruit mingled with silky tannins and rich, vanilla oak on the finish.
- 38 **VIDAL PINOT NOIR, HAWKE'S BAY** **£24.90**  
New Zealand 2009/10  
Raspberry sweetness showing through a youthful character, yet more structure and complexity developing from barrique-ageing.
- 39 **FINCA FLICHMAN MALBEC, MENDOZA** **£19.50**  
Argentina 2010/1  
An extra mellowness from time in barrel blends well with the full-bodied, ripe berry character with a touch of spice.
