| 23 | Berri Estates Shiraz, SE Australia
Medium-bodied and fruity with blackberry and cherry aromas. Red pepper, coffee and toasted vanilla flavours combine to provide good complexity on the palate. | £15.00 | £3.80 | £5.00 |

WHITES

4 Fiano del Beneventano, Sant Orsola, 2007, Italy £19.00

Honeyed palate with flavours of white peach, pear, lemon and hints of hazelnut, so typical of the Fiano variety.

5 Veramonte Sauvignon Blanc Reserva, Casablanca Valley 2007, Chile £16.90

Deliciously crisp and dry made with the aromatic Sauvignon Blanc grape. Full of green apple, grapefruit and lemongrass flavours, with a crisp, ripe acidity on the finish.

6 Sancerre Les Collinettes, Joseph Mellot 2007, France £24.50

A stylish, crisp Sauvignon with the tell-tale aroma of gooseberries and powerful fruit flavours, linked with a clean finish.

7 F.E. Trimbach Gewürztraminer 2006/07, France £30.00

A classic example with typical ripe, peachy character, full palate and dry finish. Fermented and aged in stainless steel.

8 Soave Classico Superiore le Maddalene 2005/06, Italy £22.50

Partially dried Gargenaga grapes give these richly layered honey spices and a generous barrique complexity.

9 D'Istituto Grillo Sicilia, Calatrasi 2006/07, Italy £16.40

Buttery, rich, dry white with notes of acacia honey and lemon peel.

10 Sant' Helena Pinot Grigio Collio, Vigneti Fantinel 2006/7, Italy £23.00

From the estate of Fantinel in the prestigious Collio area, this wonderful aromatic wine shows freshly dried hay, almond, pear and pineapple followed through with a rich, honeyed style.

11 Mâcon-Villages Domaine de la Grange Magnien, Louis Jadot 2006/07, France £19.00

Softer in style than wines from northern Burgundy, this Chardonnay is fresh, dry and full-flavoured. From an excellent single estate in the heart of the appellation.

12 Chablis, Domaine Gilbert Picq et Fils 2005/06, France £26.00

This is a dry, ripe Chardonnay of great style, with the gunflint characteristic for which the region is famous.

13 Robert Mondavi Winery Fumé Blanc, Napa Valley 2005/06, USA £35.00

Full-bodied, almost creamy with layers of tropical fruit, textured with subtle oak nuances.

50 Krug Grande Cuvée Brut NV, France £139.00

Barrel-fermented wines contribute toward the style of this magnificent, opulent and unique Champagne.

51 Dom Pérignon Brut 1999/00 £125.00

Roughly equal proportions of Pinot Noir and Chardonnay left to mature for 7 years prior to release.

CHAMPAGNE AND SPARKLERS

40 Pigalle Brut, France £16.00

Soft and fruity with a touch of crisp apple and nectarine on the palate. This easy-drinking, sparkling wine is made by the 'cuve close' method so that it produces a natural sparkle.

41 Asti Spumante, S. Orsola, Italy £19.90 £4.10

Elegant, yet richly fruity bouquet matched by a deliciously concentrated flavour on the palate and a stylish grapey acidity on the finish.

42 Codorníu Pinot Noir Brut Rosé, Cava, Spain £20.90 £4.50

PINK Made from 100% Pinot Noir producing a delicious pink wine packed full of summer fruits.

43 Bouché Père et Fils Cuvée Réservee Brut, France £31.00 £6.00

Light and well-balanced with good maturity and a biscuity flavour, blended from Chardonnay, Pinot Noir and Pinot Meunier.

44 Bouché Père et Fils Brut Rose, France £34.80

A fresh, modern style with a beautiful straw gold colour and fine, blended mousse backed by a soft, rich palate with flavours of biscuits and lightly roasted nuts.

45 Piper-Heidsieck Brut, France £39.00

Young, lively fruit flavours and a fresh, vivid aroma characterise this attractive Champagne, long the favourite of royal courts in Europe.

46 Piper-Heidsieck Brut Magnum 1.5 litre £79.00

47 Jeroboam Piper-Heidsieck 3 litre £159.00

48 Taittinger Brut Vintage, France 2002 £65.00

A rich, full-flavoured yet intensely elegant Champagne using the classic Pinot Noir and Chardonnay grapes from a superb vintage. A fine example of Taittinger's quality.

49 Perrier-Jouët Belle Epoque Brut, France 1999/00 £120.00

Perrier-Jouët's prestige cuvée is bursting with ripe, complex fruit character, with a long elegant finish. It is consistently one of the top quality Champagnes.

14 Bourgogne Chardonnay Couvent des Jacobins, Louis Jadot 2006/07, France £24.00

This mainly Côte d'Or sourced wine is matured in oak barrels. It has a full rich, buttery Chardonnay nose and a crisp, well-balanced palate.

15 Accademia del Sole Viognier, Calatrasi, 2006/07, Italy £17.00

Exuding classic peach and apricot aromas and flavours together with subtle hints of oak and vanilla on the finish.

16 Etchart Privado Torrontes, Salta, Argentina £15.80

Softly spiced, fresh, floral delight, dry with unmistakably fragrant characters, unique to Argentina.

17 Vidal Estator Sauvignon Blanc, Marlborough, 2007/08 £21.50

Classic Sauvignon from New Zealand.

18 Moselland Riesling Kabinett £16.00

From the region of the Saar, the wine reflects the classic, unrivalled quality which comes from the Riesling grape.

19 D'istinti Sangiovese Rosato, Calatrasi, 2007/08, Italy £15.40

Delicious, summer fruit flavours of delicate strawberry and tart raspberry. Light, vibrant and fresh, a hint of sweetness.

RED

- 24 Château Lamothe-Cissac, Cru Bourgeois Haut-Médoc 2001/02, France £24.00**
Deep garnet wine with a blackcurrant and cedar nose, it tastes round and ripe with a good, firm finish. An excellent Haut-Médoc Château.
- 25 Terre di Ginestra Nero d'Avola, Calatrasi 2007/08, Italy £20.50**
Red violet colour with purple edges. Nose is elegant and savoury Nero d'Avola. Intense palate showing bilberries and prunes with length gained from oak sweetness.
- 26 Château La Tour de Bessan, Cru Bourgeois Margaux 2004/05, France £39.00**
A harmonious marriage of the three traditional Bordeaux grapes. A round, supple style with a soft blackcurrant richness.
- 27 Tintara Grenache, McLaren Vale 2004/05, Australia £22.90**
Beautifully lifted fruit characters, subtle oak, ripe, sweet fruit and a long, smooth finish.
- 28 Re Noir Lo Zoccolaio Estate, Villa Lanata 2006, Italy £29.90**
From Pinot Noir, bright cherry and raspberry aromas backed by a rich, well structured palate with notes of liquorice.
- 29 Raimat Cabernet Sauvignon, Costers del Segre, Spain £16.00**
Ripe blackberry and cassis flavours, backed with spicy sandalwood and cedar notes.
- 30 Veramonte Merlot Reserva, Casablanca Valley 2007, Chile £17.00**
Rich and full-bodied from this popular grape. Blackberry and cherry aromas and flavours with a touch of mint and oak on the finish.
- 31 Don Jacobo Crianza Rioja Tinto, Bodegas Corral 2004/05, Spain £19.50**
A rich, full-bodied red made in the traditional way, with at least one year of oak ageing. It has a bright raspberry and cherry fruit character and a silky smooth finish.
- 32 Riserva Ducale Chianti Classico Riserva, Ruffino 2005, Italy £31.00**
Rich and concentrated, a dark, minerally palate and roasted red fruit and herb character.
- 33 Cullinan View Pinotage, Robertson, South Africa £17.00**
Rich, full and spicy with good levels of fruit aromas and flavour, made with South Africa's own grape variety.
- 34 Barolo Lo Zoccolaio, Villa Lanata 2003/04, Italy £41.00**
Very concentrated aromas and flavours of violet and game, with four years barrel age.
- 35 Fleurie Les Muriennes, Thorin 2007, France £21.50**
The name Fleurie aptly describes the fresh, floral style of the wine.
- 36 Châteauneuf-du-Pape, Domaine de l'Arnesque £32.90**
Great richness and complexity yet smooth and rounded on the finish. An excellent sample of this famous wine.
- 37 Wynns Shiraz, Coonawarra, Australia £22.90**
Typically robust in character with deep, rich fruit and a long warm, spicy finish. Aged for 12 months in new American and French oak casks to enhance its complexity and spicy character.
- 38 Vidal Estate Pinot Noir, Hawke's Bay 2005/06, New Zealand £23.90**
Medium-bodied from this classic grape, showing typical varietal fruit flavours and ripe youthful tannins. A year in French oak gives the wine added structure and complexity.
- 39 Finca Flichman Reserva Malbec Oak-Aged, Mendoza 2006/07, Argentina £18.00**
Superb intensity with heady richness and ripe, delicious red berry warmth, typically earthy in character and thriving in this climate.
